HISTORICAL FACTS ABOUT KENSINGTON

Kensington is a district in West London. Kensington is bordered to the north by Notting Hill, to the east by Brompton and Knightsbridge to the south by Chelsea and Earl's court and to the west by Hammersmith and Shepard's Bush.

Kensington is known for its shops and stores, is a densely populated area, the houses are of Victorian and Georgian terraced some consisting of 4-6 floors. There are no high rise buildings expect for the Holiday Inn which is a 27 story hotel located on Cromwell Road. Kensington is served by 3 Underground Stations High Street Kensington, Gloucester Road and South Kensington.

Kensington has a number of attractions like the Royal Albert Hall, the Royal College of Music, the Natural History museum, the Science Museum and lots more. The name Kensington could have been taken from Saxon as Kying-tun which means where a king resides as once was the case. Kensington is mentioned in the doomsday book as Chenintun and at that time its owner was a goldsmith.
